-Permitting of compost facilities that market/distribute compost containing food waste is handled through a marketing and distribution permit issued under 327 IAC 6.1-5.

-Permits can be written to either identify pre-approved waste sources or to allow quick approval of additional waste sources over the life of the permit.

-Currently no fees are assessed for marketing and distribution permits. Applications must be submitted at least 180 days prior to anticipated activity. Permits are issued for 5 years, renewable for up to 10.
